CALL FOR COMMEMORATIVE/LEGACY ART PIECE

In commemoration of the Teslin Tlingit Council hosting the first five Haa Kusteeeyí Celebrations, the Daḱká Nations are calling for Artwork entries to honour the legacy of our unique Inland Tlingit celebration. The selected art piece will embody the transition of celebration host nation duties from one Inland Tlingit Nation to the next and will be a legacy art piece.

Who Should Apply & Requirements:

- Artists who have First Nation origins from Teslin, Carcross/Tagish and/or Atlin
- Submissions must be original 2-D or 3-D art piece(s) depicting, commemorating or representing the Haa Kusteeeyí Celebration.
- Art pieces including materials and time are not to exceed the value of **\$10,000** and payment will be made upon delivery of the art piece.
- A joint committee from the three Inland Tlingit Nations will select the successful submission.

The deadline to submit a photo and description of your piece must be received no later than **Monday, July 10th, 2017 by 4pm**. The successful art piece must be ready for delivery and presentation no later than **Thursday, July 20, 2017 by 4pm**.

Specification for Submission of Art Pieces & Photos of Completed Work: To submit a completed piece of original artwork by the artist, a colour photograph of the piece must be submitted along with the dimensions, materials used and estimated value.

Eligibility: The contest is open to all interested parties, particularly professional artists, graphic designers and art students who are citizens of or beneficiaries of either Teslin Tlingit Council, Carcross/Tagish First Nation or the Taku River Tlingit First Nation. Entrants who are under the age of 18 must supply the signature of a parent or other guardian on the entry form.

Contest Terms and Conditions: By entering you are verifying the submitted work is yours, that you have the rights to the images and that you are an adult. If you are not an adult of at least 18 years of age, you will need to have a parent or guardian sign the entry form.

By participating in this competition, you are granting the Haa Kusteeyí Celebration and the Teslin Tlingit Council, the right to use the entered work on their respective websites, printed materials and for future promotions. The winning entry becomes the property of the Haa Kusteeyí Celebration host nation and will not be returned. The joint adjudicating Teslin Tlingit Council, Carcross/Tagish First Nation, the Taku River Tlingit First Nation will make the selection of the successful art piece. The Haa Kusteeyí Celebration Committee reserve the right to alter the work with text and/or logos if deemed necessary.

Finalists: Finalists are responsible for shipping or delivering original artwork to the Teslin Tlingit Heritage Centre.
